SUBJECT: Policy Letter #14: Consideration of Others Program (CO2)

1. This policy establishes the 15th Regimental Signal Brigade Consideration of Others (CO2) Program.

2. Policy/Procedures:

a. Inculcation of Consideration of Others (CO2) as a value for the 15th Regimental Signal Brigade is centered on a comprehensive education program, which involves all Soldiers and Civilian employees. The purpose of this program is to enhance trust, cohesion, and readiness by ensuring continual awareness of care as an organizational imperative.

b. The Consideration of Others Program is a commander's program which instills in all members of the command a belief and understanding in the Army's core values: Loyalty, Duty, Respect, Selfless Service, Honor, Integrity, and Personal Courage. We build and maintain an Army where people do what is right and treat each other as they want to be treated.

c. Consideration of Others methodology is the small group session. Well organized meetings in small groups are the ideal forum for building trust and teamwork within the command. To make these meetings a success, special attention must be given in identifying and training CO2 group facilitators.

d. Leader involvement at all levels is the essential ingredient to a successful program. Training is required to be executed down to the squad, team, or section level. The Brigade Equal Opportunity Advisor is available to assist these efforts.

3. A successful CO2 Program instills caring and inspires willingness in member of organizations to take personal responsibility for their attitudes, actions, and words to include adjusting when necessary to promote unity cohesion and team work.
