SUBJECT: Commander's Policy Memorandum #15 - Battalion Urinalysis Program

1. PURPOSE: This memorandum establishes policy in support of the Army Substance Abuse Program and applies to all Soldiers assigned and attached to the 442d Signal Battalion.
2. Reference: AR 600-85, The Army Substance Abuse Program, 28 December 2012
3. For purposes of this policy, 442d Soldiers are considered in two categories: permanent party and students. This policy letter applies to both groups.
4. All permanent party personnel will be tested a minimum of once each fiscal year. Commanders will accomplish this by testing 4% of total assigned personnel in their company weekly. All 4% sweeps must be on a random selection basis. It is possible that a soldier may be tested more than once during the fiscal year through random testing.
5. All student personnel assigned or attached for a period of 60 days or more will be subject to random urinalysis testing. It is possible that a Soldier could be tested more than once during their student tenure.
6. All personnel, permanent party and students, will be subject to random urinalysis testing after leave, TDY or hospital in-patient care.
7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This policy replaces Commander's Policy Memorandum #15, dated 9 January 2014.
